- 11'- With the aid of an unidentified man, John Jr. guides a small motorboat out into the bay where the <u>Honey Fitz</u> is anchored.
- 49'- An unidentified man swims with Caroline Kennedy, John Jr. and several unidentified children at the beach near the compound.
- 156'- A sequence of shots of the children riding horses while JFK watches.
- 312'- JFK and Paul "Red" Fay take John Jr. to a toy shop in town; the three drive back to the compound.
- 353'- The Kennedys and their guests walk down the pier to the Honey Fitz.
- 362'- A cruise on the Honey Fitz. Lem Billings, Pat Lawford, Anita Fay, one unidentified man, one unidentified woman and two unidentified children accompanied the President and his family.
- 683'- Preparations for a television show taped that afternoon on the lawn of the President's Hyannisport residence. JFK and Walter Cronkite are seated on the lawn waiting for the final technical adjustments to be completed.
- 731'- JFK and his family drive to his father's residence.
