MS = Medium shot  
LS = Long shot

#### Shot List

- 0'- Series of mood shots at Arlington Cemetery.
- 18'- CU of the printed program for Veteran's Day activities at the Cemetery.
- 21'- Mood shots.
- 26'- LS of the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier and the crowds attending the ceremony.
- 36'- President Kennedy and John F. Kennedy Jr. arrive at the cemetery. General David M. Shoup accompanies the President to the Tomb.
- 41'- John Jr. remains near the car with a secret service agent.
- 43'- LS of the Tomb.
- 45'- John Jr. "inspects" a soldier on guard duty near the President's limousine.
- 51'- The color guard precedes President Kennedy and his aides as the group approaches the Tomb.
- 70'- President Kennedy and his aides stand at attention before the Tomb during the National Anthem.
- 120'- A guard aids President Kennedy in the presentation of the flowers at the Tomb.
- 138'- President Kennedy returns to his position before the Tomb.
- 150'- While Taps is played, the camera pans the area.
- 180'- A moment of silence is observed by all before a gun salute.
- 204'- An unidentified Marine officer speaks in the amphitheatre. No sound from this event.
- 209'- President Kennedy and an unidentified man listening to the remarks of the officer in the amphitheatre.
- 214'- Miscellaneous cemetery shots ending with a LS of the site of the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier.
- 263'- End action.
